## POLICY BRIEF 1

The 1st Policy Brief of Natural Origins project addresses the critical challenges and opportunities presented by the current migration and refugee crisis. This brief highlights the need for comprehensive integration strategies, improved legal frameworks, and enhanced collaboration with EU guidelines to support migrants in their new homes effectively.



## POLICY BRIEF 2

The 2nd Policy Brief proposes targeted recommendations to promote entrepreneurship, including simplifying business registration processes, enhancing access to finance, providing business training and networking opportunities, and fostering inclusivity through cultural exchange programs. It highlights the entrepreneurial spirit of migrants and the structural barriers they face.



## POLICY BRIEF RECOMMENDATIONS

Natural Origins project made a great and significant progress with the contributions of all the project partners from Cyprus, Spain, Türkiye, Ireland, Italy and Greece. We developed the first two policy briefs, which focused on the topics “Migrants and Migrant Entrepreneurship”.
